BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED, that on this the 22nd day of May, 2012, at 6:00 p.m., in accordance with a resolution of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, adopted on the 13th day of March, 2012, and recorded in the records of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley in the Minute Book,, notice of which regular meeting was issued and published according to law, the undersigned members of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, being a quorum thereof, met in the chambers of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, City Hall, Crowley, Louisiana, and, according to law, publicly examined and canvassed the returns of the Special Election held on the 19th day of May, 2012, in the City of Crowley, as shown by the official tabulation of ballots on the compiled statement of election returns verified by the Clerk of Court of the Parish of Acadia, according to law, which compiled statement was prepared by the Board of Elections Supervisors of the Parish of Acadia on the 22nd day of May, 2012 in accordance with said resolution, to determine the following propositions, to-wit:

**CITY OF CROWLEY PROPOSITION (ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT
(1/2 OF 1%) SALES AND USE TAX)
(City Infrastructure & Capital Improvements)**

SUMMARY: ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2 OF 1%) 15-YEAR SALES AND USE TAX FOR ACQUIRING, CONSTRUCTING, MAINTAINING AND IMPROVING INFRASTRUCTURE AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY, WITH THE PROCEEDS OF THE TAX TO BE SUBJECT TO FUNDING INTO BONDS.

Shall the City of Crowley, State of Louisiana (the "City"), under the laws of Louisiana, be authorized to levy and collect, and adopt an ordinance providing for such levy and collection, a tax of one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) (an estimated \$1,334,888.00 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of tax for an entire year) (the "Tax") upon the sale at retail, the use, the lease or rental, the consumption and the storage for use or consumption of tangible personal property and on sales of services in the City, all as defined by law, for a period of fifteen (15) years from an effective first levy date of July 1, 2012, with the proceeds of the Tax to be dedicated and used for the purposes of acquiring, constructing, maintaining and improving infrastructure and capital improvements within the City; and further, shall the City be authorized to fund the proceeds of

the Tax into bonds to be issued in series from time to time for any of the aforesaid capital purposes as permitted by the laws of Louisiana?

The results of the canvassing and tabulation of said election returns provided by the Clerk of Court for **City of Crowley Proposition (One-Half of One Percent (1/2 of 1%) Sales and Use Tax** proved to be: **37 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 1(P), North Crowley Middle School, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **11 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **42 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 2(P), Notre Dame High School, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **25 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **47 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 3A(P), North Crowley Kindergarten, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **18 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **31 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 3B(P), North Crowley Kindergarten, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **12 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **46 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 4, Acadia Parish Courthouse Lobby, First Floor, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **19 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **12 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 5, Crowley City Hall, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **7 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **14 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 6, Old Ross High School, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **14 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **31 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 7(P), Rice Festival Building, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **36 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **36 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 8(P), Immaculate Heart of Mary Church Hall, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **21 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **25 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 9, South Crowley Elementary School, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **17 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **17 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 11(P), Martin Luther King, Jr. Center, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **9 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **48 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 12(P), School Board Media Center, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **16 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **0 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 12A, School Board Media Center, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **2 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **5 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 13(P), School Board Media Center, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **3 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **0 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 13A(P), School Board Media Center, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **0 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **0 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 14(P), Acadia Animal Clinic, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **0 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **0 ballots** cast at Ward 6 Precinct 16(P), LSU Rice Experiment Station, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **0 ballots** cast at said polling place **against** the proposition; **200 absentee ballots** cast at the Acadia Parish Courthouse, Crowley, Louisiana **in favor of** the proposition and **106 absentee ballots** cast at the Acadia Parish Courthouse, Crowley, Louisiana **against** the proposition, and therefore the majority of voters qualified to vote under the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana voting at said election in said City were **in favor of City of Crowley Proposition (One-Half of One Percent (1/2 of 1%) Sales and Use Tax**.

NOW THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, declare that the results of said election to be in favor of **City of Crowley Proposition (One-Half of One Percent (1/2 of 1%) Sales and Use Tax** and therefore the proposition passed.

In accordance with law, a resolution promulgating the aforesaid results was adopted and the City Clerk was ordered to have a certified copy of said resolution signed by the Mayor and published in one issue of the Crowley Post Signal, the Official Journal of the City of Crowley, Louisiana.

We did, likewise, order that one certified copy of the Proces Verbal and one certified copy of the resolution be sent to the Secretary of State to be recorded in the archives of the State of Louisiana and that one certified copy of the Proces Verbal and one certified copy of the said resolution be sent to the Clerk of the 15th Judicial District Court of the Parish of Acadia, Louisiana, to be recorded in the records of the Clerk and Recorder of said Parish,

and that the original Proces Verbal and the original resolution be filed in the archives of the City of Crowley, State of Louisiana.

The following resolution was offered by Alderman Vernon Martin, duly seconded by Alderman Lyle Fogleman, and adopted.

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, PROMULGATING THE RESULTS OF A SPECIAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF CROWLEY, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, ON THE 19TH DAY OF MAY, 2012, TO DETERMINE THE PROPOSITION TO AUTHORIZE THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2 OF 1%) SALES AND USE TAX; AND TO PROVIDE FOR ALL MATTERS RELATIVE THERETO.

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of May, 2012, a Special Election was held in the City of Crowley, to determine the proposition hereinafter set forth; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen received the compiled statement of all ballots cast in each precinct and absentee ballots of said election from the Board of Elections Supervisors of the Parish of Acadia on the 22nd day of May, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the complied statement of the ballots cast at said Special Election were canvassed by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, according to law and under notice duly given as provided by law, on the 22nd day of May, 2012, and the result of said election was declared to be that a majority of the qualified voters of the said City of Crowley voting at said election voted in favor of **City of Crowley Proposition (One-Half of One Percent (1/2 of 1%) Sales and Use Tax,**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, IN SPECIAL SESSION DULY CONVENED, THAT:

SECTION 1. An election was held in the City of Crowley on the 19th day of May, 2012, to determine the Proposition hereinafter set out.

That said election was duly and properly called by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley by resolution adopted on the 13th day of March, 2012, and recorded in the Minute Book of the Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, and that said resolution stated the purpose for which the proposed tax was to be levied, the number of years which the proposed tax was to run; and that notice of the election, embracing substantially all matters required by law to be contained therein, was given by publication in the Crowley Post Signal, the Official Journal of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, on the following dates: April 3, April 10, April 17 and April 24, 2012; the first of said publication being not less than forty-five (45) days prior to the date of said election nor more than ninety (90) days between the date of first publication and the date of said election as shown by the Affidavit of Publication thereof; that this Board did, in said resolution, designate the polling places for the said election and did provide all necessary equipment therefor; that the Registrar of Voters for the Parish of Acadia furnished to the election commissioners a list of voters entitled to vote in said election; that only qualified electors under the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana voted at such election; that the ballots used in said election were in the form provided by law; that the officials to serve at said election were duly and properly appointed by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, and that the places of all absent commissioners and clerks of election were properly filed in accordance with law, and that, before the opening of the polls, all commissioners and clerks were properly sworn, in accordance with law; that the polls at said polling places were opened at 6:00 o'clock a.m. and remained opened until 8:00 o'clock p.m.; that, after the closing of the polls, the voting machine election result sheets and election result cartridges, together with the tabulation blank and compiled statement form, were delivered to the Clerk of Court of Acadia Parish, Louisiana, by the commissioners in charge, in accordance with law, and the results from each precinct and the absentee ballots were duly tabulated by the Clerk of Court of Acadia Parish, Louisiana, and transmitted to the Secretary of State; that on the 22nd day of May, 2012, the Board of Elections Supervisors met to break the seals and open the voting machines to review the compiled statements and declare the official ballots as cast in the election; and that all things whatsoever required and duly performed in a manner and form provided by Title 39, Section 501 et seq., and Title 18, the General Election Law of Louisiana Revised Statutes, as amended, of the State of Louisiana and the Louisiana Constitution of 1974.

SECTION 2: That in said election, the following proposition was approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting at said election in said City of Crowley:

SECTION 4: The results of said election shall be promulgated by the City Clerk by publication of this resolution one time in the Crowley Post Signal, a newspaper published within the corporate limits of Crowley, Acadia Parish, Louisiana.

SECTION 5: All orders, resolutions and ordinances, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith be, and the same are hereby repealed.

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF CROWLEY, ACADIA PARISH, LOUISIANA, INTRODUCING A PROPOSED ORDINANCE FOR THE LEVY OF A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2 OF 1%) SALES AND USE TAX, CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING AND A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF ADLERMEN TO CONSIDER ADOPTION OF SAME.

WHEREAS, an ordinance has been proposed to be adopted by the Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley; and

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance must be introduced by its title; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing must be held prior to its adoption; and

WHEREAS, the title of the proposed ordinance must be published once in the official journal and the notice shall provide the date, time and place where the Board will consider its adoption;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Acadia Parish, Louisiana, that the following ordinance be and it is hereby introduced for consideration at the special meeting of the Mayor and Board of Aldermen after the public hearing, to-wit:

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE LEVY, COLLECTION AND ADMINISTRATION OF A ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2%) TAX UPON THE SALE AT RETAIL, THE USE, THE LEASE OR RENTAL, THE CONSUMPTION AND THE STORAGE FOR USE OR CONSUMPTION OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY AND ON SALES OF SERVICES, ALL AS

DEFINED HEREIN; DEFINING THE TERMS "TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY", "DEALER", "SALE", "RETAIL SALES", "LEASE OR RENTAL", "STORAGE", "USE", "SALES OF SERVICES", AND OTHER TERMS USED HEREIN; LEVYING AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT, COLLECTION, PAYMENT AND DEDICATION OF SUCH TAX AND THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE PROCEEDS OF SAID TAX MAY BE EXPENDED; PROVIDING FOR AN ADEQUATE REMEDY AT LAW; DEFINING VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE AND THE COLLECTION OF THE TAX LEVIED THEREBY; PROVIDING THAT ANY PART OF THIS ORDINANCE WHICH MAY BE HELD INVALID OR UNCONSTITUTIONAL SHALL NOT AFFECT OR IMPAIR ANY OTHER PROVISIONS THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL RESOLUTIONS AND ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF AS MAY CONFLICT HEREWITH.
