1. Contact your insurance company first – whether you have flood insurance or not.
2. Register with FEMA
To be considered for all forms of disaster assistance (individual and business), victims must first call the

FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA)

When they call, they will be asked, among many things, for their bank routing and checking account numbers – this is for direct deposit in the event they are approved. If they call, they should have this ready.
