

CITY OF CROWLEY  
REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
NOVEMBER 8, 2005

The Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Crowley, Louisiana, the governing authority of the City of Crowley, met in a regular session at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday the 8<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2005, at the regular meeting place of said Mayor and Board of Aldermen, the City Hall, 426 North Avenue F, Crowley, Louisiana.

Mayor de la Houssaye presided with the following Aldermen present: Dr. James M. Buatt, Tiger Istre, Woody Marceaux, Mary T. Melancon, Laurita D. Pete, Steven C. Premeaux, Ira Thomas and Kitty Valdetero. Alderman Vernon Martin was absent.

Alderman Buatt led the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag and Alderman Marceaux gave the invocation.

Alderwoman Melancon offered a motion to amend the agenda to consider a request for annexation from Dr. John Burgin for 1.785 acre tract of land. Seconded by Alderman Thomas and duly adopted after a unanimous vote.

Alderwoman Valdetero offered a motion to amend the agenda to consider the wastewater collection system for LIMCO Subdivision No. 2. Seconded by Alderwoman Melancon and duly adopted after a unanimous vote.

**PUBLIC HEARINGS:**

Mayor de la Houssaye opened the public hearing on proposed ordinance no. 1327, the ordinance to amend the fiscal 2006 budget was read by title.

Mr. Regan asked for opponents to the proposed ordinance no. 1327. A third and final call was made with no one coming forward to speak.

The call for proponents of the proposed ordinance no. 1327 was made and there were no comments after the third and final call.

Mayor de la Houssaye called the public hearing to a close.

**READING & APPROVAL OF MINUTES / BILLS:**

Alderman Istre moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the October 11<sup>th</sup>, 2005 regular council meeting and approve them as written and distributed. Seconded by Alderman Thomas and duly adopted.

Alderwoman Valdetero moved to dispense with the reading of the minutes of the October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2005 special council meeting; and approve them as written and distributed. Seconded by Alderman Buatt and duly adopted.

Alderwoman Melancon moved to approve all bills presented for payment. Seconded by Alderman Thomas and duly adopted.

**MAYOR'S REPORT:**

Mayor de la Houssaye presented the Sales Tax chart and User Fee chart that tract the collection trend since fiscal 1992. The Recap of all Funds Report compares actual revenues and expenditures for the fiscal year 2005 to the budgeted revenues and expenditures of the same period.

Alderwoman Melancon offered a motion to authorize Mayor de la Houssaye to negotiate with a state agency on rental space at the Enterprise Center. Seconded by Alderman Buatt and duly adopted.

**STANDING COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**PUBLIC WORKS:**

Alderman Melancon offered a motion to refer to the Drainage Board a request for review of the retaining wall in the ditch next to 626 East Hutchinson Avenue. Seconded by Alderman Thomas and duly adopted.

Alderman Melancon offered a motion to approve the bid tabulation and engineer's recommendation for awarding a contract for the FY 05-06 Annual Street Repair Contract at tonight's meeting. Seconded by Alderman Pete and duly adopted.

Alderman Buatt offered a motion to accept the recommendation of Mader Engineering and award the contract to Le Talley Ho Construction, Inc. in the amount of \$144,225.00 for the FY 05-06 Annual Street Repair. Seconded by Alderman Marceaux and duly adopted.

Alderman Melancon offered a motion to authorize the Mayor and Mader Engineering to meet with Mitchell Istre to decide what Drainage projects can be done by the Street Department in the amount not to exceed \$45,500. Seconded by Alderman Valdetero and duly adopted.

Alderman Melancon offered a motion to authorize the Mayor to enter into a contract with Pavement Markings, Inc. for Pedestrian Striping on Eastern Avenue between 6<sup>th</sup> Street and Northern Avenue. Seconded by Alderman Marceaux and duly adopted.

**UTILITY:**

Alderman Marceaux offered a motion to table Phase I of Replacement of Sewer Lines in the 2005-06 Fiscal Year for East Park Subdivision in the estimated amount of \$220,000 and to proceed with the I & I repairs. Seconded by Alderman Thomas and duly adopted.

Alderman Valdetero offered a motion to authorize the Mayor to engage the services of Bruce Soileau to provide quarterly inspections and routine maintenance of the UV Disinfection system at the Wastewater Treatment Facility at an estimated cost of \$800-\$1,000 per quarter. Seconded by Alderman Thomas and duly adopted.

The following resolution was offered by Alderman Valdetero, duly seconded by Alderman Istre, and duly resolved and adopted.

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the City Engineer and the Planning Commission of the City of Crowley, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen approved the plans and specifications of the wastewater collection system and connections to be constructed by the developer and required a bond to be posted by the Developer in favor of the City of Crowley to ensure the completion of the sewer and wastewater collection system and improvements; and

Alderman Marceaux offered a motion to grant a conditional use for Calvin Ardoin to park three mobile homes on Lots 11 and 12, Block 56, Original Crowley with a variance of 500 square feet and a five foot setback on the rear lot for a minimum of twenty feet. Zoning on Lot 11, Block 56, Original Crowley will revert back to a R-3 designation. Seconded by Alderman Thomas and duly adopted with Alderman Buatt voting nay.

Alderman Marceaux offered a motion to expedite to the Planning Commission for their consideration to annex and subdivide property belonging to Dr. John Burgin. Seconded by Alderwoman Valdetero and duly adopted.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, if any provision, part, word, section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance and do hereby declare the provisions hereof, to be severable, then in that event, only that particular provision, part, word, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase shall be deemed unconstitutional or invalid and the remaining provisions, parts, words, sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases will not be affected and shall continue in full force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
